

## **FAQ's**

### **Q: What ages does the Peace Pavilion appeal to the most?**

A: Learning about peace concepts is appropriate for all ages, but the exhibits are geared toward children aged 5-12. There is also a Toddler Room whose activities mirror the peace lessons in the exhibit areas.

### **Q: Is the Peace Pavilion accessible to people with limited mobility?**

A: Yes, the Peace Pavilion is all on one level, and has accessible doorways, restrooms and parking spaces.

### **Q: Is there a café or place to eat at the Peace Pavilion?**

A: [You may rent the Community Room or Picnic Space](#) for a separate fee. Otherwise, there is a park nearby with playgrounds, picnic shelters, and splash park.

### **Q: Do you schedule tours for groups of people with developmental disabilities?**

A: Yes.

### **Q: Are there any discounts for daily admissions or annual memberships?**

A: The Peace Pavilion has Discount Days several times a year, and annual memberships are available. The memberships pay for themselves after four visits per year.

### **Q: Does the Peace Pavilion have a gift shop?**

A: Yes! Anything you see in the shop is also available for purchase at the front desk.

### **Q: Does the Peace Pavilion accommodate those with sensory challenges?**

A: [The facility can be rented](#) for groups with sensory challenges.

### **Q: What is your policy regarding service animals?**

A: Service animals are allowed to accompany people with disabilities who use them for assistance.

### **Q: Can I take a tour before committing to a visit?**

A: Yes, we are happy to take you on a short tour of the exhibit spaces and other rooms we have to offer.
